MinistrySafe is the official abuse prevention system for all churches in the Central Texas Conference. ALL new UMVIM Team Leaders are now required to be compliant with this policy BEFORE attending a training class. Please contact your church to fill out this form* if you are MinistrySafe compliant or to complete the process. This includes the five steps of MinistrySafe Compliance: 1) Application, 2) Interview, 3) Reference Checks, 4) Background Check, 5) Online Training, as well as agreeing to follow the CTC approved MinistrySafe policy for ministry with children and youth. Please remember that even if you do not have children or youth on your teams, they will be around us where we serve.
