In order to promote a safe environment for all children, youth and adult participants in Central Texas Conference sponsored events with children and youth, each church must certify that those working or chaperoning with children and youth are MinistrySafe certified in their local church. This includes the five steps of MinistrySafe Compliance: 1) Application, 2) Interview, 3) Reference Checks, 4) Background Check, 5) Online Training, as well as agreeing to follow the CTC approved MinistrySafe policy for ministry with children and youth.
